Roll Call Release. DHS, FBI, and ITACG write the RCR to share terrorist tactics and techniques with "street-level" first responders. RCRs are available on HSIN-I and LEO.

Terrorism Summary. This daily SECRET-level digest of terrorism-related intelligence is posted on NCTC CURRENT-SECRET (CURRENT-S). The TERRSUM is written for law enforcement and security officers, as well as military personnel.
